Committee Descriptions

Ways and Means: This committee plans fundraisers to provide money for the Council's community projects, scholarships, and ABPAC etc. This committee is responsible for the Boston Butt Sale and other fundraisers.

Membership/Spikette/New Member Reception: This committee will coordinate membership drives in conjunction with the National Women's Council drives. This committee will recognize Spikette status among members. Representatives of this committee should attend new member receptions along with the President to orient new members, and recruit new members.

GMHBA Installation Dinner: This committee works to decorate for the GMHBA annual Installation Dinner. It involves ordering and putting into place all table decorations and other decorations needed to decorate the facility chosen by the GMHBA.

Luncheons (Past Presidents and Boss Appreciation): This committee is responsible for planning specific luncheons. This involves ordering and sending invitations to honorees, table decorations, gifts, and door prizes and confirming with the Program Committee that a guest speaker is planned.

Past President: This committee should be comprised of the 5 past presidents and any other past president desiring to serve whose purpose it is to give guidance to the Executive Committee when called on to do so by the President.

Scholarship Selection / Award: After a determined amount of money is received from proceeds of a fundraiser, this committee solicits applications to area high schools directed toward students interested in pursuing careers in the building industry. This committee will determine scholarship winners.

The Big Cook Off: This committee is responsible for organizing the Women's Council booth at the Big Cook Off and gathering volunteers to participate in the event.

Programs: This committee shall work with the Vice Presidents to ensure that a program and/or speaker has been planned for the monthly meetings. For example: guest speakers, get-to-know-you, Christmas party.

Spring Tour of Homes / Parade of Homes: This committee is responsible for gathering and scheduling volunteers for the Parade of Homes and / or the Spring Tour of Homes.

Home Expo: This committee is responsible for gathering and scheduling volunteers to participate in the Home Expo in a manner that will best represent the Council.

Community Projects: This committee will work on one or more projects to aid someone or some group in the community. This committee shall work with the Vice President and Program Chairs to schedule community project speaker slots.

Presidents Project: This committee is responsible for working with the GMHBA staff to complete the GMHBA President's scrapbook keepsake.

Golf Tournament: This committee is responsible for gathering and scheduling volunteers to participate in the Golf Tournament in a manner that will best represent the Council.
